

The European Media Freedom Act Implementation: The European Regulators Group for Audiovisual Media Services is restructured. Albania maintains the status as an observer

AMA's Chair, Ms. Armela Krasniqi, participated in the latest plenary session of the European Regulators Group for Audiovisual Media Services. This meeting marked a decisive step toward the institutional consolidation of the European Board for Media Services (EBMS), in other words the transition from ERGA to the new governance structure, EBMS, within the framework of implementing the European Media Freedom Act. Albania maintains its status as an observer in the EBMS, even after the transformation of this European network.

In March there was an increase in political news coverage in audiovisual media. According to data calculated by AMA's monitoring and analysis teams, political news accounts for 26.94%, followed by international news at 12.40%, and social news at 11.18%.
