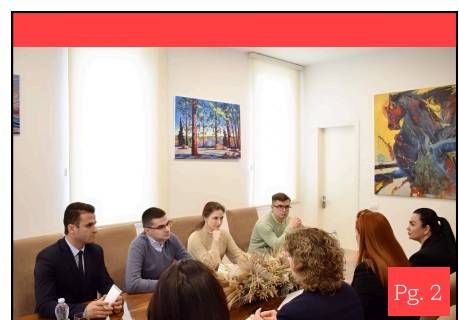

Safeguarding minority rights in audiovisual broadcasts, the Estonian delegation in AMA

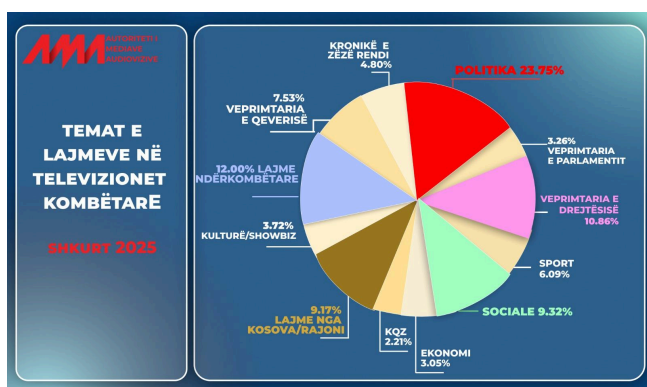
