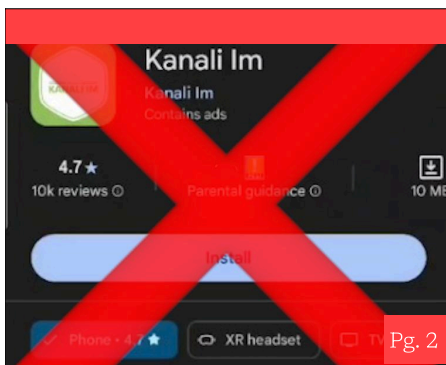

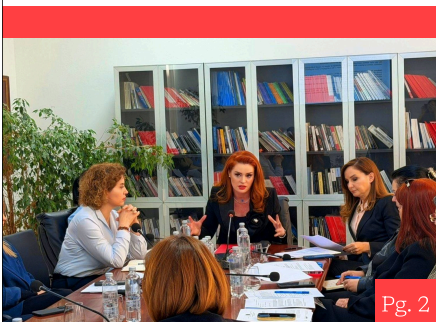

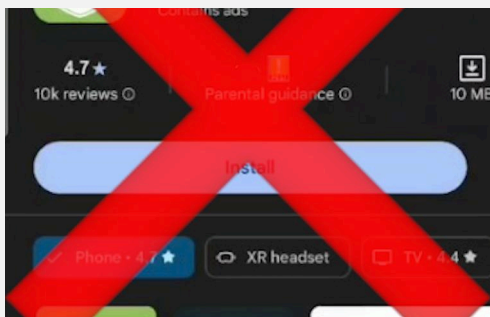

In protection of Albanian audiovisual production, following AMA's request, the applications "Kanali im" and "Shiko Shqip" have been removed from the Google Play Store

The applications "Kanali im" and "Shiko Shqip," which were illegally streaming Albanian television channels, have been removed from the Google Play Store following the identification of broadcasting rights violations. The request came after a verification process conducted by AMA's inspection teams, which found that the applications offered unauthorized access to Albanian television channels and copyrighted audiovisual content.

AMA's Chairwoman welcomed representatives of audiovisual media service providers, with whom she consulted on several additions and amendments to the regulation, "On audio and audiovisual commercial communications, their formats, conditions and the permitted daily duration of advertising broadcasts". The consultation came as a result of legislative changes following the European Audiovisual Media Services Directive transposition.

The fight against piracy in 2025: 14 illegal servers were shut down and 579 pirated links were removed from video sharing platforms

The fight against audiovisual piracy continues to be a key priority of Audiovisual Media Authority's work during 2025. Thanks to continuous on-site inspections, AMA teams successfully shut down 10 pirate servers in Albania, while 4 others were blocked abroad. Additionally, 334 online pages were referred for closure, while 579 pirate links were removed from video sharing platforms.
