Krasniqi: AMA's independence is measured by indicators, not by perceptions. The courts have confirmed the legality of our decisions

The Audiovisual Media Authority Chairwoman, Armela Krasniqi, reported today to the Parliamentary Committee on Human Rights and Means of Public Information regarding the institution's annual work report for the previous year. She emphasized that "during 2025, AMA's Board adopted approximately 110 decisions, while over the past 5 years more than 550 decisions have been adopted, over 67% of which with unanimous agreement". In her word, Ms. Krasniqi stated that "this demonstrates decision-making grounded in law, professionalism and institutional accountability".

They exchanged views on European practices and the shared challenges faced by institutions, the media and democratic societies in the context of rapid technological developments.

The national media literacy campaign, "Media Literacy for School-Age Students," continues. In this context, AMA's Chairwoman, Ms. Armela Krasniqi, and the Head of the Council of Complaints, Ms. Mirela Oktrova, held interactive discussions with students and teachers at "Qemal Stafa" High School in Tirana and with students at "Naim Frashëri" High School in Durrës.

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AMA-TikTok-X Platform Transparency: Increase in the removal of harmful content from the platforms

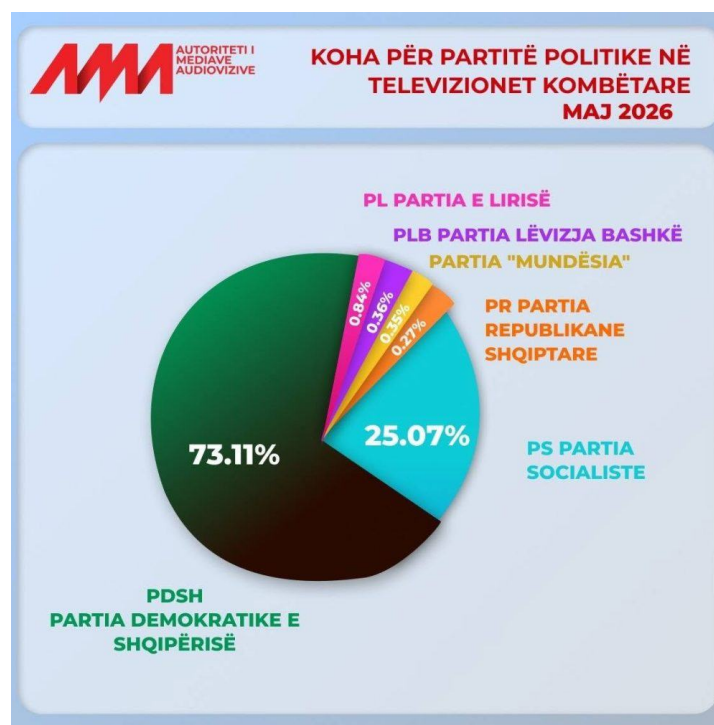
During June, the Audiovisual Media Authority published data on its cooperation with TikTok in identifying and addressing harmful content, as well as cases involving Albanian audiovisual works piracy. By the end of the reporting period, AMA has handled 225 complaints, of which 89 were assessed as law violations, resulting in the removal of 65 pieces of content from the platform. Meanwhile, regarding Platform X, AMA handled a total of 70 pieces of content reported by the public, 26 of which were identified as law violations.

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Content monitoring during May: Political parties, state institutions and dominant actors on national television channels

The content monitoring data for May, prepared by the analysis teams at the Audiovisual Media Authority, present the distribution of airtime allocated to political parties, the presence of state institutions and the synchronous actors across national television channels. The political parties monitoring shows that the Democratic Party of Albania accounted for 73.11% of total airtime, followed by the Socialist Party with 25.07% and the Freedom Party with 0.84%.
