

Armela Krasniqi was elected as Chairperson of the Audiovisual Media Authority by decision of the Assembly of the Republic of Albania, on July 7, 2021.

Also, she is currently a professor in Journalism and Communication, in the Bachelor and Master programs, at the Universities of Pristina and Albania.

Armela Krasniqi was elected as EPRA Vice-Chairperson at the 59th EPRA Meeting in Rotterdam on 6 June 2024 and joins the EPRA Board for the first time, for a period of one year.

Mrs. Krasniqi is holding the position of the President of MNRA, elected during the 22nd Plenary Assembly of this organization.

During her career she was elected as a member of the executive board of EANA (European Alliance of News Agencies) in September 2019 until July 2021.

Another international position was the election as a President of ABNA (The Association of the Balkan News Agencies Southeast Europe) in November 2018.

She has a considerable management experience in different public and private institutions in Albania, such as Director General of the Albanian News Agency; Director General of the Information and Public Relations Department in the Prime Minister Office; Director of the News Department in the Public Television; General Tax Department, private televisions, etc.

Mrs. Krasniqi graduated on 1999 in the Faculty of Journalism at the University of Tirana (Albania). She holds several qualifications from the University of Perugia, Presidency of Umbria (Italy) in 2000 and Cabinet Office and Number 10 London (United Kingdom) in 2016. She has track records and expertise with international companies like Price Water House and Coopers (PwC) 2020 – 2021.

Topics related to media freedom, the digital era of media, the future of journalism and the fight against disinformation are and were the key issues that she most contributed to.
